

NSG Public Statement
Extraordinary Plenary Meeting
Vienna, 4 - 6 September 2008

The Nuclear Suppliers Group (NSG) met in Vienna on 4 - 6 September to continue its discussion of a U.S. draft proposal on a statement on civil nuclear cooperation with India.

During the meeting, Participating Governments¹ exchanged views and addressed a series of questions concerning the draft and adopted the Statement on Civil Nuclear Cooperation with India by consensus.

The NSG will ask the Director General of the IAEA, Mohammed ElBaradei, to publish its decision as an INFCIRC document.
